

## **Muncie Central Football Spectator Plan**

Rationale: Football is different than other sports venues. Teams are separated from each other by the field (except for those playing) and the teams are also separated from the fans by part of the track on both sides. FB teams have separate locker rooms and restrooms.

I have calculated the number of socially distanced seats that we have in the stadium. The home side has 403 and the visitor side has 157. There will be a painted X on the useable seats.

My proposal is to allow 250 fans on the home side and 100 fans on the visitor side. (For many of our games there will be less than 100 visiting fans that attend).

- We will allow family units to sit together as long as the unit has 6 feet of separation from other fans.
- Students may sit together in a section, but they must sit on an X that is marked on the seats.

Tickets will be pre-sale.

- Week of home game for our fans will be during the school day. We will set up a sales table for specific hours at Door #1.
- Visiting team will be sent 100 tickets for pre-sale

The South ticket gate will be for home fans and the North ticket gate will be for visiting fans. We will only scan tickets at the gates. We will have marks on the pavement for social distancing at the gates.

Visiting fans will be directed to walk around the track at the north end to get to their seats.

Face coverings are required at all times for spectators ages 8 and above. This will be enforced by gate personnel, security, school administrators, visiting administrators, PA announcements every 5 to 10 minutes.

We will have 3- 5 porta-pots for the visiting side with hand sanitizer available. We will also have a satellite concession stand by the visiting bleachers for their fans.

Between the 2 teams, security, workers, media, concession workers, ambulance crew, athletic trainers, team doctors, ball boys, managers, home cheerleaders and administration there will be additionally up to 250 more people.

Officials will dress in the school building and will be escorted to and from the field.

Home team Cheerleaders will be distanced from the team on the track towards the North end of the bleachers. No visiting team cheerleaders.

The Muncie Central band will not play at the games.

Concession stands will sell pre-packaged items (including foil wrapped hot dogs, boxed or closed bag popcorn, nacho cheese cups with lids and prepackaged chips – all made up before the game. Candy bars and 20oz bottles of pop and water.) All workers in appropriate PPE. Separate person to handle cash box. Packages of condiments on request.

Once again, this will be in 3 main sections. Home side (250), inside track (250), Visitor side (100).
