Northside Middle School goes to remote learning until January 19

Muncie, Ind. – Officials at Muncie Community Schools have decided to temporarily close Northside Middle School until next week in response to a recent uptick in positive COVID-19 test results at the school. Students will shift to e-learning, utilizing the district's [Schoolology](#) learning management system, for the rest of this week. In-person learning is expected to resume on Tuesday.

“We wanted to be extra cautious here since we have seen a small increase in cases in a short period of time,” MCS Director of Public Education and CEO Lee Ann Kwiatkowski said. “We consulted the County Health Department and they fully support this decision.”

All after school activities at Northside are cancelled during this temporary closure, but all other MCS buildings will be open as usual. There is no school Monday, Jan. 18, in observance of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day.
